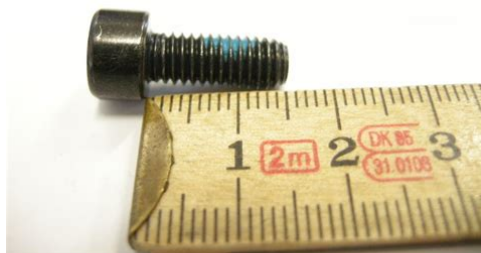

What's the trick How do you clear the lines of air Although they came prebled, I had to cut the hose to size, and install a new olive and end fitting, so the system was opened. I tried following the Shimano instructions and the instructions on the Park website, but no pressure at the lever. The weird thing was, sometimes after tapping the calipers with a screwdriver and flicking the lines, I would get some pressure, but then if I would do a few more cycles of the the lever and opening the bleed nipple, the pressure would disappear. I don't have a syringe, so I just had a tube going from the nipple into a bottle, submerged in fluid. When I first squeezed the lever, some fluid came out of the nipple into the tube, but subsequent squeezing of the lever and opening the nipple would not cause more fluid or bubbles to come out. There seemed to be no rhyme or reason why pressure would appear, and then further bleeding would make it disappear, so I kept doing it till I got pressure, and then stopped. However, they are pretty mushy. I have bled many, many car and motorcycle brakes before, and never had this problem! They came prebled but were going to be cutting the rear hose down this coming weekend so we will be bleeding that system. WRT to bleeding brakes the procedure should be Insert the yellow brake bleeding block into the caliper. Hook up the bleeder tube thingie at the caliper. Squeeze the brake lever, giving gentle pressure. Release the bleeder valve, allowing any fluid to escape. Close the bleeder valve probably less than a half second open at max. Release lever.

Check fluid level in the reservoir. Repeat until you are satisfied that there is no more air in the system. Absolutely make sure that you have not allowed the reservoir to completely drain out as this will introduce air into the system at the top of the system which you will then have to drive all the way through to the caliper to get out. As far as your brakes are concerned, it seems to me that you are reintroducing air into the system somehow. Try following the above procedure and see what happens. Keep at it. With a completely dry system it could take some time to fill the system with fluid as the air compresses when you squeeze the lever. You can even try pumping the lever a few times to build pressure until the lever feels firm up. Releasing the bleed valve will allow the air to escape. ConsumerREVIEW.com, a business unit of Invenda. In the rear, braking forces far exceed 10x driving forces so that a wheel designed solely for driving forces won't be as strong as needed, especially in crucial braking situations where the wheel may be also experiencing a very hard hit. They are really a pain in the ass since the spokes do not bend quite like bicycle wheels do. Go into any motorcycle dealer and take a look. One issue most bicycle wheelbuilders will face when working with this pattern is that lacing the rear wheel it is done from one side to the other like a motorcycle

wheel, rather than from the inside to the outside as has been standard practice with bicycles for years. The goal of this pattern is to keep the outside spokes on each respective side in full tension while braking and only the drive side of the rear wheel being changed. See below from Shimano instructions. The rear is laced like a motorcycle wheel. Any wheel lacing pattern must be designed around braking, not necessarily driving. Braking forces are tenfold driving forces. Only on the drive side of the rear wheel is this not the case.

Now, Shimano has begun saying that the nonbraking side of the front wheel when using a HBM965 can be radial. A poor choice in my opinion. The inner spokes of the rear wheel will be placed on each side of the valve hole. At this point, the hub label should be pointing directly at the valve hole. This is how a Shimano front wheel lace goes together. The greater the tangent of the spokes to the hub flange, the more directly drive and braking forces are transmitted. It spreads the load around the rim and hub while resisting windup under power and braking. A 4Cross pattern is almost totally unnecessary due to the selection of downhill rims available. I prefer using 32 hole rims on all my mountain bikes since I may destroy a rim at anytime and most shops do not stock a selection of 36 hole rims. I built a set of road wheels like this for my wife.
